ORDINANCE NO. 167-2012

TITLE: TRANSFER OF FUNDS – FIRE DEPARTMENT JOINT DISPATCH PROJECT

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING AN APPROPRIATION OF \$70,000 FROM THE FIRE DEPARTMENT CAPITAL BUDGET TO THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OPERATING BUDGET, TO COVER THE CITY'S SHARE OF THE JOINT DISPATCH PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the sum of Seventy Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$70,000.00) is hereby transferred from an appropriation from the Fire Department Capital Budget to the Fire Department Operating Budget, to cover the City of Barberton's share of the Joint Dispatch Project with Copley and Norton. These funds will be paid directly to Copley Township, the acting Fiscal Agent for this project until the COG is officially formed.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, and for the reason that the funds are needed as soon as possible due to time constraints associated with the LGIF loan for this project, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
