TITLE:

ENTER INTO CONTRACT – QCI 31ST STREET NW / CLEVELAND MASSILLON ROAD WATERLINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH QUALITY CONTROL INSPECTION (QCI), IN THE AMOUNT OF \$142,840, FOR CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING MANAGEMENT FOR THE 31ST STREET NW / CLEVELAND MASSILLON ROAD WATERLINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this is a joint project, with Norton and Barberton sharing the costs; and

WHEREAS, the monies will be drawn from Issue I funds at zero interest from the Ohio Public Works Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a professional services contract with Quality Control Inspection (QCI), as determined by the Cities of Norton and Barberton and awarded by the Board of Control, in the amount of One Hundred Forty Two Thousand Eight Hundred Forty Dollars and No Cents (\$142,840.00) for the 31st Street NW / Cleveland Massillon Road Waterline Replacement Project.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order for the project to commence in a timely manner, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
