## TITLE: 2023 STREET CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BUDGET

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE STREET CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND OF THE CITY OF BARBERTON FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2023 AND PROVIDING FOR THE ADMINISTRATION THEREOF, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**SECTION 1.** That in order to provide for expenses and other expenditures of the following funds of the City of Barberton for the period beginning January 1, 2023, the following sums be and the same are hereby set aside and appropriated by legal level as follows:

**SECTION 3.** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

**SECTION 4.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, and for the reason that it concerns the efficient operation of the City, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise, to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
