ORDINANCE NO. 173-2012

TITLE: ENTER INTO CONTRACT – PROTECTOPLAS COMPANY WATER TREATMENT PLANT

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH PROTECTOPLAS COMPANY, IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$24,360.75, TO PURCHASE A TANK LINER AND A NEW "POST DAY TANK" FOR THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, due to previous contracts with Protectoplas Company this past year, the total amount exceeds Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00), thus requiring Council approval through an ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into contract with Protectoplas Company, in the total amount of Twenty Four Thousand Three Hundred Sixty Dollars and Seventy Five Cents (\$24,360.75), to purchase a tank liner (for \$23,085.25) and a new "post day tank" (for \$1,275.50) for the Water Treatment Plant.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the purchases to be made as soon as possible, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
