ORDINANCE NO. 175-2014

**TITLE: INCREASE OF CONTRACT - THRASHER ENGINEERING
E. TUSCARAWAS AVENUE and FOURTH STREET NE**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE OF THE CONTRACT WITH THRASHER ENGINEERING, BY \$25,000, TO PERFORM CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATION AND INSPECTION SERVICES FOR THE STORM SEWER EXTENSION AT E. TUSCARAWAS AVENUE AND FOURTH STREET NE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it was approved in Ordinance No. 65-2014 that the Mayor enter into contract with Thrasher Engineering in the amount of Twenty Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$20,000.00); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That this Council hereby authorizes an increase in the amount of the original contract with Thrasher Engineering in the amount of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$25,000.00), totaling Forty-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$45,000.00), to perform Construction Administration and Inspection Services for the storm sewer extension at E. Tuscarawas Avenue and Fourth Street NE.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that the increase in the amount of the contract is needed as quickly as possible in order to proceed with the projects in a timely manner, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
