ORDINANCE NO. 176-2012

TITLE: APPROPRIATION – MUNICIPAL COURT COURT SPECIAL PROJECTS FUND

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$17,000 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE COURT SPECIAL PROJECTS FUND TO THE COURT SPECIAL PROJECTS FUND PERSONAL SERVICES BUDGET; AND APPROPRIATING \$58,000 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE COURT SPECIAL PROJECTS FUND TO THE COURT SPECIAL PROJECTS FUND OPERATING BUDGET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, reimbursement for up to \$50,000 for consultant services shall be provided by a grant from the State Justice Institute; and

WHEREAS, the remaining \$25,000 will serve as grant matching funds for consultant services and personal services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the sum of Seventeen Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$17,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Item of the Court Special Projects Fund to the Court Special Projects Fund Personal Services Budget; and the sum of Fifty Eight Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$58,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Item of the Court Special Projects Fund to the Court Special Projects Fund Operating Budget.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, and for the reason that the funds are needed as soon as possible in order to proceed with certain projects, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
