TITLE: AMATS GRANT REQUEST

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION BY THE DIRECTOR OF PLANNING TO AMATS TO BUILD A CONNECTOR TRAIL FROM THE 2ND STREET TOWPATH TRAILHEAD WEST ALONG WOOSTER ROAD, ACROSS WOOSTER ROAD AT FOURTH STREET AND INTO THE PARKING AREA BEHIND THE THEATER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this project is a key section identified in the AMATS Connecting Community Grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

- **SECTION 1.** That Council hereby approves the submission of a grant application by the Director of Planning to AMATS to build a connector trail from the 2^{nd} Street Towpath Trailhead Wet along Wooster Road, across Wooster Road at Fourth Street and into the parking area behind the theater
- **SECTION 2.** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.
- **SECTION 3.** That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that the City must apply for this funding as soon as possible due to an application deadline, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
