TITLE: 2015 STREET/ROAD SALT

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH CARGILL DEICING TECHNOLOGY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$214,920 FOR THE 2015 STREET/ROAD SALT PROGRAM THROUGH THE OHIO STATE COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM, PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 42-1995, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into contract with Cargill Deicing Technology, for the 2015 street/road salt program for Two Hundred Fourteen Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty Dollars and No Cents (\$214,920.00), through the Ohio State Cooperative Purchasing Program, pursuant to Ordinance No. 42-1995. The price establishment is through CUE bid of 4000 tons of conveyed salt at \$53.73 per ton.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, to be able to execute the contract in a timely fashion, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
