

ORDINANCE NO. 18-2023

**TITLE: APPROPRIATION
FINANCE DEPARTMENT**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$500,000 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE GENERAL FUND TO THE MISCELLANEOUS GENERAL FUND OPERATING AND MAINTENANCE BUDGET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this is coming from a previous year’s purchase order being closed when it shouldn’t have and was for the redevelopment grant for the Cox-Powell building (136-2021).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$500,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Item of the General Fund to the Miscellaneous General Fund Operation and Maintenance Budget.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of it’s committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order to re-open this purchase order as soon as possible, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after it’s passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
