RESOLUTION NO. 185-2013

TITLE: APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STP FUNDS

A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR FEDERAL SURFACE TRANSPORTATION (STP) FUNDS PROGRAMMED BY THE AKRON METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY (AMATS) TO IMPROVE WOOSTER ROAD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Wooster Road is vital to the City; and

WHEREAS, this main thoroughfare must be maintained to allow safe and efficient mobility for and through the City of Barberton; and

WHEREAS, the Wooster Road is in need of milling and resurfacing of approximately 3,600 lineal feet of asphalt pavement between Hopocan Avenue to Norton Avenue. Restriping and limited base repair are included in the proposed project scope.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for Federal Surface Transportation Program (STP) Funds programmed by the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS) for the following asphalt resurfacing project:

WOOSTER ROAD RESURFACING from Hopocan Avenue to Norton Avenue involving the milling and resurfacing of approximately 3,600 lineal feet of asphalt including limited base repair and restriping. The budgetary cost for said project is \$600,000.

SECTION 2. That the City of Barberton acknowledges and understands the AMATS "Funding Policy Guidelines" and confirms to the best of its knowledge that the information contained in the project application is accurate, that it intends to diligently pursue that project, and that a local share is required to match federal funds.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meeting open to the public and in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is to apply for this funding within the next 30 days, and provided that it receives the approval of two-thirds of the members of Council, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
