

ORDINANCE NO. 190-2012

**TITLE: APPROPRIATION – FIRE DEPARTMENT
 NEW RADIO SYSTEM**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$851,724 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE FEMA GRANT FUND TO THE FEMA GRANT FUND CAPITAL BUDGET (DUE TO THE 2011 ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT); AND APPROPRIATING \$94,636 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE GENERAL FUND TO THE FIRE DEPARTMENT CAPITAL BUDGET, FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$946,360, TO PURCHASE THE NEW RADIO SYSTEM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the sum of Eight Hundred Fifty One Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty Four Dollars and No Cents (\$851,724.00) is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Item of the FEMA Grant Fund to the FEMA Grant Fund Capital Budget (due to the 2011 Assistance to Firefighters Grant); and appropriating Ninety Four Thousand Six Hundred Thirty Six Dollars and No Cents (\$94,636.00) from the Unappropriated Item of the General Fund to the Fire Department Capital Budget, for a total amount of Nine Hundred Forty Six Thousand Three Hundred Sixty Dollars and No Cents (\$946,360.00), to purchase the new radio system.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that funds are needed as soon as possible due to time constraints on the contract, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
