ORDINANCE NO. 20-2015

TITLE: APPROPRIATION W. HOPOCAN AVENUE

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$199,558 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE STREET CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND TO THE STREET CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT CAPITAL BUDGET TO SATISFY THE CITY OF BARBERTON'S COMMITMENT TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S IMPROVEMENT OF W. HOPOCAN AVENUE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the sum of One Hundred Ninety-Nine Five Hundred Fifty Eight Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$199,558.00) is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Item of the Street Capital Improvement Fund to the Street Capital Improvement Capital Budget to satisfy the City of Barberton's commitment of the Ohio Department of Transportation's (ODOT) improvement of W. Hopocan Avenue (SUM – Hopocan PID 98364) which includes funding in excess of the City's required match in order to execute potential project improvements that may be considered.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, and for the reason that the funds are needed in order to have funding in place within ODOT required timeframes, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
