ORDINANCE NO. 23-2015

TITLE: ENTER INTO AGREEMENT – O.D.N.R.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PARKS & RECREATION DEPARTMENT TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES (O.D.N.R.) – DIVISION OF WATERCRAFT FOR A BOATER SAFETY EDUCATION GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$8,797.66, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Parks & Recreation Department is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, Division of Watercraft for a Boater Safety Education Grant in the amount of Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety Seven and Sixty Six Cents (\$8,797.66) for the purpose of running a Southern Summit County Water Exploration Program and the Summer Youth Adventure Camp which will include boating safety, wakeboarding and waterskiing. This grant will also fund some maintenance and training costs.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order for the City to process the application as soon as possible, provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
