## TITLE: MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING SUMMIT COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH

**RESOLUTION NO. 26-2021** 

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) WITH THE SUMMIT COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH (SCPH) TO PROVIDE COMPLIANT SERVICES FOR THE CITY'S NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS,** these services include administration of the illicit discharge detection and elimination (DDE) program; and

**WHEREAS,** the MOU is for a total of five years for an amount not to exceed \$24,804.19 during the contract term.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That this Council hereby authorizes the Mayor, or his designee, to execute an amended memorandum of understanding (MOU) with the Summit County Department of Public Health (SCPH) to provide compliant services for the City's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit.

**SECTION 2.** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is necessary to have the agreement executed and returned to SCPH in preparation for screening and sampling to begin in early spring, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
