## **ORDINANCE NO. 31-2014**

## TITLE: APPROPRIATION WOOSTER ROAD WEST IMPROVEMENTS

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$102,955 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE PERMISSIVE LICENSE TAX FUND TO THE PERMISSIVE LICENSE TAX FUND CAPITAL BUDGET FOR THE RESURFACING OF WOOSTER ROAD WEST FROM TAYLOR ROAD TO KRANCZ DRIVE (PID #92729), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS,** Council approval through an ordinance is required for additional authorization of purchase orders dated after the obligation date when the amount exceeds Three Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$3,000.00).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That the sum of One Hundred Two Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty-Five Dollars and No Cents (\$102,955.00) is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Item of the Permissive License Tax Fund to the Permissive License Tax Fund Operating Budget, for the resurfacing Wooster Road West from Taylor Road to Krancz Drive.

**SECTION 2.** That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

**SECTION 3.** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

**SECTION 4.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, and for the reason that the funds are needed as soon as possible in order to proceed with this project in a timely manner, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
