

ORDINANCE NO. 32-2014

**TITLE: APPROPRIATION
31ST STREET NW**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$487,747.13 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENT RESERVE FUND TO THE INFRASTRUCTURE RESERVE FUND CAPITAL BUDGET FOR THE 31ST STREET NW PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the sum of Four Hundred Eighty Seven, Seven Hundred Forty Seven Dollars and Thirteen Cents (\$487,747.13) is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Item of the Infrastructure Improvement Reserve Fund to the Infrastructure Reserve Fund Capital Budget for the widening, planning and resurfacing to incorporate a two-way left turn lane on 31st Street and minor side street improvements. The work also includes replacing the roadway drainage system and a new signal installed at the Shannon Avenue intersection, lying within the City of Barberton.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, and for the reason that the funds are needed as soon as possible in order to proceed with this project in a timely manner, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
