ORDINANCE NO. 35-2017

TITLE: APPROPRIATION PLANNING GRANTS

- AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$6,500 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE CITY GRANT FUND TO THE OPERATING BUDGET OF THE CITY GRANT FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
- **WHEREAS,** two (2) grants were awarded to the City of Barberton. The first was the Creating Healthy Communities Grant in the amount of \$1,500 and the second was the Partnerships in Motion Grant in the amount of \$5,000.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:
- **SECTION 1.** That the sum of Six Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and No Cents (\$6,500.00) is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Item of the City Grant Fund to the Operating Budget of the City Grant Fund.
- **SECTION 2.** That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.
- **SECTION 3.** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.
- **SECTION 4.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, and for the reason that the funds may be used in a timely manner, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
