TITLE: MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT – SUMMIT SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT AND THE CITY OF BARBERTON

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BARBERTON TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE SUMMIT SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT (SWCD) TO ENCOURAGE COOPERATION TOWARDS THE ATTAINMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE GOALS IN THE COMMUNITY'S NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PHASE II MUNICIPAL STORM WATER PERMIT.

WHEREAS, the City of Barberton is responsible for carrying out the mandated responsibilities inherent in the NPDES (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System) Phase II Storm Water Permit; and

WHEREAS, the City of Barberton recognizes the need for effective collaboration with other communities to successfully implement water quality education programs for its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Summit SWCD has the technical and education expertise and staff to assist communities with such cooperation; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the community to work with the Summit SWCD to assist the community and provide reasonable cooperation to Summit SWCD to this end.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That this Council hereby authorizes the City of Barberton to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding Agreement between Summit Soil and Water Conservation District and the City of Barberton.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
