ORDINANCE NO. 41-2017

**TITLE: FOUNDATION GRANT REQUEST – PARKS
LITTER COLLECTION PROGRAM**

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION BY THE DIRECTOR OF PARKS AND RECREATION TO THE BARBERTON COMMUNITY FOUNDATION, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$900, TO BE USED TOWARDS A CITYWIDE LITTER COLLECTION PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Council hereby approves the submission of a grant application by the Director of Parks and Recreation to the Barberton Community Foundation, in the amount of Nine Hundred Dollars and No Cents (\$900.00), to be used towards a Citywide Litter Collection Program for supplies such as gloves, safety vests, Adopt-A-Road Program signs, and food for volunteer groups participating in the cleanups, etc.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason to process the application as soon as possible, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
