SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for Resurfacing Funds programmed by the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS) with an estimated cost of this project listed below and in acknowledgement of the AMATS "Funding Policy Guidelines":

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason to facilitate timeliness, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
