TITLE: APPROPRIATION – 911 PHONE SYSTEM

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$6,709.35 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE 911 PHONE SYSTEM FUND TO THE 911 PHONE SYSTEM FUND SERVICE BUDGET AND TRANSFERRING \$10,000 FROM THE 911 PHONE SYSTEM OPERATING BUDGET TO THE 911 PHONE SYSTEM PERSONAL SERVICE BUDGET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the sum of Six Thousand Seven Hundred Nine Dollars and Thirty-Five Cents (\$6,709.35) is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Item of the 911 Phone System Fund to the 911 Phone System Fund Personal Service Budget and transferring Ten Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$10,000.00) from the 911 Phone System Operating Budget to the 911 Phone System Personal Service Budget, for the wages/benefits of our former dispatches in January of this year prior to them becoming SWSCOM employees.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order to proceed with this project in a timely manner, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
