ORDINANCE NO. 56-2016

TITLE: ENTER INTO CONTRACT SUMMIT COUNTY

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH SUMMIT COUNTY TO PROVIDE ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES TO THE CITY, EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 1, 2015, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

- **SECTION 1.** That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a professional services contract with Summit County, to provide animal control services to the City effective December 1, 2015.
- **SECTION 2.** That the Finance Director is hereby directed to pay the County for past services provided to the City by the Division of Animal Control.
- **SECTION 3.** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.
- **SECTION 4.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order for the City to process this as quickly as possible, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
