TITLE: CHANGE ORDER – STANTEC WATER TREATMENT PLANT

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER WITH STANTEC FOR THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT REHABILITATION / REPLACEMENT PROJECT FOR ADDITIONAL DESIGN ADMINISTRATION SERVICES DUE TO A CHANGE IN SCOPE OF SERVICES, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$219,900, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, due to an existing contract with Stantec regarding the Water Treatment Plant Project, the costs for additional Design Administration Services must be covered, exceeding Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$25,000.00), and thus requiring Council approval through an ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

- **SECTION 1.** That a change order for the sum of Two Hundred Nineteen Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars and No Cents (\$219,900.00) with Stantec is hereby authorized for the Water Treatment Plant, Rehabilitation/Replacement Project.
- **SECTION 2.** That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.
- **SECTION 3.** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.
- **SECTION 4.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is necessary to authorize a change order for additional funds as soon as possible in order to proceed with the project, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
