

**ORDINANCE NO. 55-2021**

**TITLE: APPROPRIATION  
STORM WATER DEPARTMENT – ARTHUR STREET**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$141,773.00 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE FEMA FUND TO THE STORM WATER CAPITAL BUDGET OF THE FEMA FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, this money is for expenses related to the Arthur Street Hazard Mitigation Grant Program and will be reimbursed.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That the sum of One Hundred Forty-One Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-Three Dollars and No Cents (\$141,773.00) is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Item of the FEMA Fund to the Storm Water Capital Budget of the FEMA Fund.

**SECTION 2.** That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

**SECTION 3.** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

**SECTION 4.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, and for the reason to begin work as soon as possible without delay, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
