TITLE: ENTER INTO CONTRACT 2014 STREET MAINTENANCE PROGRAM

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH KARVO PAVING, THE LOWEST AND/OR BEST BIDDER, FOR THE 2014 STREET MAINTENANCE PROGRAM, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$727,256.05, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into contract with Karvo Paving, the "lowest and/or best" bidder as determined and awarded by the Board of Control, for the 2014 Street Maintenance Program, in an amount not to exceed Seven Hundred Twenty Seven Thousand, Two Hundred Fifty-Six Dollars and Five Cents (\$727,256.05).

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order to begin the maintenance program in a timely manner, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
