ORDINANCE NO. 58-2017

TITLE: APPROPRIATION **CITY PARKS**

 $\mathbf{A}\mathbf{N}$ **ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING** \$100,000 **FROM** THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENT RESERVE FUND, \$10,000 TO THE PARKS OPERATING BUDGET AND \$90,000 TO THE PARKS CAPITAL OUTLAY BUDGET FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL PROJECTS AND UPGRADES IN OUR CITY PARKS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, a majority vote of seven members of City Council is needed in order to appropriate the funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$100,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Item of the Infrastructure Improvement Reserve Fund, Ten Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$10,000) to the Parks Operating Budget and Ninety Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$90,000.00) to the Parks Capital Outlay Budget for various capital projects and upgrades in our city parks.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, and for the reason that the funds are needed as soon as possible in order to apply for the grant application in a timely manner, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
