TITLE: COMMENDATION – NICHOLAS & SUSANNA KURTZ

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BARBERTON TO HONOR AND GIVE PUBLIC RECOGNITION TO NICHOLAS & SUSANNA KURTZ WHO CELEBRATED THEIR 75<sup>TH</sup> WEDDING ANNIVERSARY ON JUNE 14, 2016.

WHEREAS, Nicholas Kurtz married the former Susanna O’Hara on June 14, 1941 at St. Mary’s Church in Homer City, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, Nicholas was employed as a coal miner in Pennsylvania and did not like it so he and Susanna came to Barberton by bus to find a better job. They chose Barberton because Susanna had an older sister who lived in town; and

WHEREAS, In 1942 Nicholas entered the Navy. After serving four years, Nicholas returned and worked at Ohio Brass for 37 years. Susanna worked at Isaly’s and Rutledge Drug Store at 4<sup>th</sup> Street and Tuscarawas Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Nicholas and Susanna have lived in the same house on 8<sup>th</sup> Street for 70 years. They have four children: Patrick, Michael, Susan, Nancy and 8 grandchildren. Susanna will soon turn 98 and Nicholas will soon be 100; and

WHEREAS, Nicholas and Susanna believe the secret to a long marriage is “Be Good to Each Other and Have a Good Sense of Humor”; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Barberton hereby honors and gives public recognition to Nicholas and Susanna Kurtz as they celebrate their 75 years of marriage.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.
