ORDINANCE NO 65-2019

TITLE: CHANGE ORDER / AUTHORIZE PAYMENT

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CERTAIN ADDITIONAL STORM WATER IMPROVEMENTS WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) REGARDING THE INCLUSION OF S.R. 619 IN THE UPCOMING I-76 INTERCHANGE RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT AT EAST AVENUE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$41,330; AND AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO PAY THE INVOICE FOR SAID AMOUNT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the inclusion of S.R. 619 within this project will realize a cost savings through economies of scale, while also allowing us to take advantage of Federal Urban Paving Funds.

WHEREAS, Council approval through an ordinance is required for additional authorization of purchase orders dated after the obligation date when the amount exceeds Three Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$3,000.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is here by authorized to add certain storm water improvements to the project resulting in an additional expense of Forty-One Thousand Three Hundred Thirty Dollars and No Cents (\$41,330.00); and hereby authorizing the Director of Finance to pay the invoice for said amount.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is necessary to authorize a change order for additional funds as soon as possible in order to proceed with the ongoing project and to pay ODOT in a timely manner, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
