**ORDINANCE NO. 66-2014**

**TITLE: ENTER INTO CONTRACT –  
2014 ASPHALT PAVING CONTRACT**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND/OR BEST BIDDER, FOR THE 2014 ASPHALT PAVING CONTRACT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the “lowest and/or best” bidder, as determined and awarded by the Board of Control, in an amount to be determined, for the second set of bids of the 2014 Paving Contract.

**SECTION 2.** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

**SECTION 3.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order that the additional streets can be added to the contract for this year, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
