

**ORDINANCE NO. 71-2020**

**TITLE: APPROPRIATION  
FIRE DEPARTMENT**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$8,750 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE FIRE CAPITAL LEVY TO THE FIRE DEPARTMENT CAPITAL BUDGET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, this money is due to a reimbursement the Fire Department received from the CARES Act for a disinfecting system, which was a COVID-19 related purchase.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That the sum of Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars and Zero Cents (\$8,750.00.00) is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Item of the Fire Capital Levy to the Fire Department Capital Budget.

**SECTION 2.** That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

**SECTION 3.** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

**SECTION 4.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that they may replenish their budget as soon as possible to be able to make other capital expense purchases without delay, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
