

ORDINANCE NO. 74-2019

**TITLE: APPROPRIATION – STREETS
STREET MARKINGS**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$7,500 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE PERMISSIVE LICENSE TAX FUND TO THE PERMISSIVE LICENSE TAX FUND OPERATING BUDGET IN ORDER TO PERFORM STREET MARKINGS IN A CONTRACT ADMINISTERED THROUGH THE COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this contractual obligation was previously approved under Ordinance 8-2019; and

WHEREAS, the County has accepted bids and an accurate cost has been forwarded to the City by the County.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, County of Summit and State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1. That the sum of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and Cents (\$7,500.00) is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated item of the Permissive License Tax Fund to the Permissive License Tax Fund Operating Budget in order to perform street markings in a contract administered through the County of Summit (County).

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, and for the reason that the funds are needed in order to meet project commencement, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
