

ORDINANCE NO. 77-2017

**TITLE: TRANSFER / APPROPRIATION
ABATEMENT AND DEMOLITION**

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING \$26,310 FROM THE TRUST FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND; AND APPROPRIATING \$26,310 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE GENERAL FUND TO THE PLANNING DEPARTMENT OPERATING BUDGET, FOR THE ABATEMENT AND DEMOLITION OF 57 21ST STREET, 423 WOOSTER ROAD NORTH AND 233 5TH STREET NE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the sum of Twenty-Six Thousand Three Hundred Ten Dollars and No Cents (\$26,310.00) is hereby transferred from the Trust Fund's to the General Fund; and that the sum of Twenty-Six Thousand Three Hundred Ten Dollars and No Cents (\$26,310.00) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Planning Department Operating Budget to be utilized for the abatement and demolition of 57 21st Street, 423 Wooster Road North and 233 5th Street NE.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, and for the reason that the funds are needed as soon as possible in order to facilitate project timeliness, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
