## TITLE: SUPPLY AGREEMENT AMENDMENT NATURAL GAS AGGREGATION PROGRAM

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO SUPPORT THE CONTINUATION OF A GOVERNMENTAL NATURAL GAS AGGREGATION PROGRAM WITH OPT-OUT PROVISIONS PURSUANT TO SECTION 4929.26, OHIO REVISED CODE, DIRECTING THE TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO ITS SUPPLY AGREEMENT WITH CONSTELLATION NEWENERGY (CONSTELLATION) TO CONTINUE A NATURAL GAS AGGREGATION PROGRAM BEYOND NOVEMBER 2021 WHEN THE CURRENT SUPPLY AGREEMENT ENDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS,** the Ohio Legislature has enacted natural gas deregulation legislation ("H.B. No. 9") which authorizes the legislative authorities of Cities, Villages, Townships and Counties to aggregate the retail natural gas loads located in the respective jurisdictions and to enter into service agreements to facilitate for those loads the purchase and sale of natural gas; and

**WHEREAS**, governmental aggregation provides an opportunity for residential and small business customers collectively to participate in the potential benefits of natural gas deregulation through lower natural gas rates which they would not otherwise be able to have individually; and

**WHEREAS**, this Council finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the City, its residents, businesses and other Natural Gas consumers located within the limits of the City to continue its Natural Gas opt-out Aggregation Program subject to the conditions of a Natural Gas Supply Agreement that will take effect on or about November 2021.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to take all administrative action necessary to support the continuation of the City's Natural Gas Aggregation Program including entering into an Amendment to its Master Service Agreement for Natural Gas Supply Services with Constellation (attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A) to facilitate the sale and purchase of Natural Gas to consumers in the City's opt-out program.

**SECTION 2.** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order to take advantage of the current pricing options, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
