## TITLE: TRANSFER/APPROPRIATION

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING \$1,910.70 FROM THE TRUST FUND'S CASH BALANCE TO THE STREET MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR FUND AND APPROPRIATING SAID AMOUNT FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE STREET MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR FUND TO THE STREET DEPARTMENT'S PERSONAL SERVICES OPERATING BUDGET FOR THE NECESSARY COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE SCOPE OF EMERGENCY WORK COMPLETED BY THE STREET DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That the sum of One Thousand Nine Hundred Ten Dollars and Seventy Cents (\$1,910.70) is hereby transferred from the Trust Fund's Cash Balance to the Street Maintenance and Repair Fund and appropriating said amount from the Unappropriated Item of the Street Maintenance and Repair fund to the Street Department's Personal Services Operating Budget for the necessary costs associated with the scope of emergency work completed by the Street Department to clear and secure the roadway caused by a fallen tree on the property of 696 East Paige Avenue.

**SECTION 2.** That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

**SECTION 3.** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

**SECTION 4.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, and for the reason that timeliness is of the essence, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
