WHEREAS, the restaurant located at 1115 Wooster Rood North has grown over the years to include 4 additions and now seats 180 guests inside and serves breakfast, lunch and dinner 7 days a week; and

WHEREAS, Fa-Ray's has been known for their home cooking, great prices, great service and a family friendly atmosphere and serves an average of 800 customers a day; and

WHEREAS, Fa-Ray's has been an important establishment in the City of Barberton for many generations of residents and employs 28 people, five who have been with the restaurant over 20 years; and

WHEREAS, David was previously recognized by the South Summit Chamber of Commerce as Businessman of the Year, a very deserving recognition and with David's leadership and business savvy we look forward to having Fa-Ray's as an integral part of the community for many years to come; and

WHEREAS, Council would like to thank and congratulate the Boshara Family for serving this community for the last 70 years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:
