## TITLE: BUSINESS INCENTIVE PROGRAM

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND SUPPORTING THE BUSINESS INCENTIVE PROGRAM THAT WILL BE USED TO HELP SPUR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; ATTRACTING NEW BUSINESSES TO BARBERTON AND THE EXPANSION OF CURRENT BUSINESSES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS**, Barberton Works, Barberton's Business Incentive Program offers monetary incentives to businesses occupying new and or existing industrial, commercial, or retail building where such occupancy creates new jobs and or eliminates blight (as defined by current City programs) from the community to enhance economic development, creating a minimum of 10 jobs;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City of Barberton of Summit County, Ohio, with all members thereof concurring:

**SECTION 1.** That the City of Barberton adopts and supports the Business Incentive Program that will be used to help spur economic development; attracting new businesses to Barberton and the expansion of current businesses.

**SECTION 2.** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

**SECTION 3.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that we can start promoting the program to interested businesses, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
