

ORDINANCE NO. 89-2018

TITLE: ADOPTION OF CIVIL SERVICE RULES

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH AND ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS THAT ESTABLISH STANDARDS, EXAMINATIONS, RULES AND CREDITS, AND PROCEDURES FOR APPOINTMENTS AND PROMOTIONS WITHIN THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the voters of the City of Barberton at the general election held in this City on September 10, 2013, adopted a Charter Amendment for the City of Barberton to formally provide the Civil Service Commission with the powers related to the “Home Rule” provision of the Ohio Constitution, provided such rules and regulations are approved by Council; and

WHEREAS, the City now wishes to establish and adopt Civil Service Rules.

WHEREAS, the City of Barberton Civil Service Commission approved the rules on July 5, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Council hereby adopts the City of Barberton Civil Service Rules dated June 28, 2018.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is necessary to maintain good order and implementation of objective, equitable rules and processes of the classified service with the City, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
