## TITLE: ADOPTING THE OPBA POLICE OFFICERS AGREEMENT

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BARBERTON ADOPTING AND APPROVING THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BARBERTON AND THE OPBA POLICE OFFICERS, EFFECTIVE FROM JANUARY 1, 2014 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2016, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That the Council of the City of Barberton hereby adopts and approves the collective bargaining agreement between the City of Barberton and the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association (OPBA) for Police Officers effective January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2016, and repeals all other ordinances in conflict therewith.

**SECTION 2.** That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

**SECTION 3.** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

**SECTION 4.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it concerns the efficient operation of the City and because the Director of Finance must pay certain employees approved compensation upon performance of services, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
