TITLE: APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STP FUNDS BARBERTON ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR FEDERAL SURFACE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM (STP), RESURFACING, OR TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) FUNDS PROGRAMMED BY THE AKRON METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY (AMATS) TO IMPROVE CERTAIN STREETS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for Federal Surface Transportation Program (STP), Resurfacing, or Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Funds programmed by the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS) with estimated cost of any of these projects has yet to be determined and in acknowledgement of the AMATS "Funding Policy Guidelines":

SECTION 2. That the City of Barberton acknowledges and understands the AMATS "Funding Policy Guidelines" and confirms to the best of its knowledge that the information contained in the project application is accurate, that it intends to diligently pursue that project, and that a local share is required to match federal funds.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order to comply with the deadline, and provided it receives the approval of two-thirds of the members of Council, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
