

ORDINANCE NO. 96-2020

**TITLE: APPROPRIATION
FIRE CAPITAL IN THE CITY GRANT FUND**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$20,000 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE CITY GRANT FUND TO THE FIRE CAPITAL IN THE CITY GRANT FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Barberton Fire Department received a \$20,000 grant from the Howmet Aerospace Foundation to purchase a vehicle and structural collapse rescue stabilization equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the sum of Twenty-Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$20,000.000) is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated item of the City Grant Fund to the Fire Capital in the City Grant Fund.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, and for the reason that the funds are needed to make this purchase within the grant program's timeline, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
