TITLE: ENTER INTO AGREEMENT SOUTHWEST SUMMIT COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH SOUTHWEST SUMMIT COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS (SWSCOG), THE CITY OF NORTON AND THE TOWNSHIP OF COPLEY IN CONNECTION WITH THE LEASE-PURCHASE OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY EQUIPMENT FOR SWSCOG; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Barberton has determined to acquire certain information technology equipment (the "Equipment") from Dell by lease-purchase with Dell Financial Services L.L.C., which Equipment be contributed by the City to the Southwest Summit Council of Governments ("SWSCOG") for use by SWSCOG in furtherance of its dispatch operations and the provision of information technology services by SWSCOG; and

WHEREAS, the City of Norton ("Norton") and Copley Township ("Copley") have agreed to assist with paying the costs of the Equipment and, in furtherance thereof, have agreed to enter into the agreement in the form attached hereto as **Exhibit A** (the "Agreement") pursuant to which Norton and Copley will each agree to pay 33.3% of the annual cost of the acquisition of the Equipment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

- **SECTION 1**. The Mayor is authorized and directed to execute and deliver to Norton, Copley and SWSCOG the Agreement in the form attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.
- **SECTION 2.** This Council hereby authorizes the Mayor and the Director of Finance to take such actions as shall be necessary in furtherance of the purposes of this Ordinance and the Agreement.
- **SECTION 3.** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.
- **SECTION 4.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is necessary to assist SWSCOG with the necessary upgrades to dispatch and information technology services for the City, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
