

ORDINANCE NO. 98-2014

**TITLE: POLICE LABOR CONTRACT
FACT FINDING REPORT**

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE FACT FINDING REPORT ON THE UNRESOLVED ISSUES BETWEEN THE CITY OF BARBERTON AND THE OHIO PATROLMEN’S BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION (OPBA) AS THE REPRESENTATIVE FOR THE POLICE OFFICERS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Barberton and OPBA Police Officers have submitted their contract proposals to a Fact Finder; and

WHEREAS, the Fact Finder has issued a report that must be accepted or rejected by City Council within seven (7) days.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Council hereby accepts the recommendations of the Fact Finding Report dated July 17, 2014, and herein attached, between the City of Barberton and OPBA Police Officers according to Section 4117 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the reason that it concerns the efficient operation of the City and time is of the essence, and it shall, therefore, be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
