Saturday noon-10:00pm

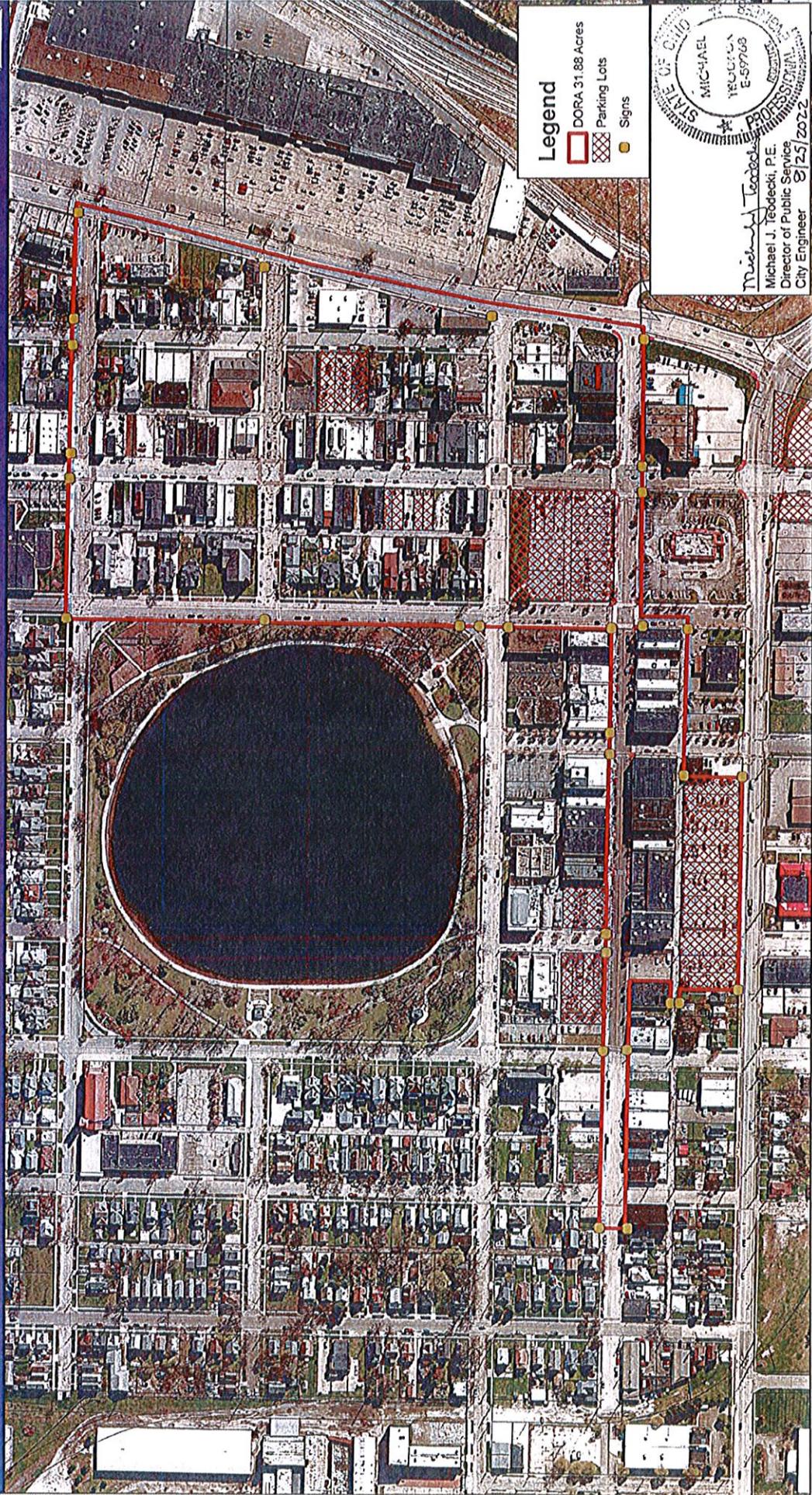

Request for extended times for special events must be proposed at-least ninety (90) days prior to the event to ensure proper approval and planning.

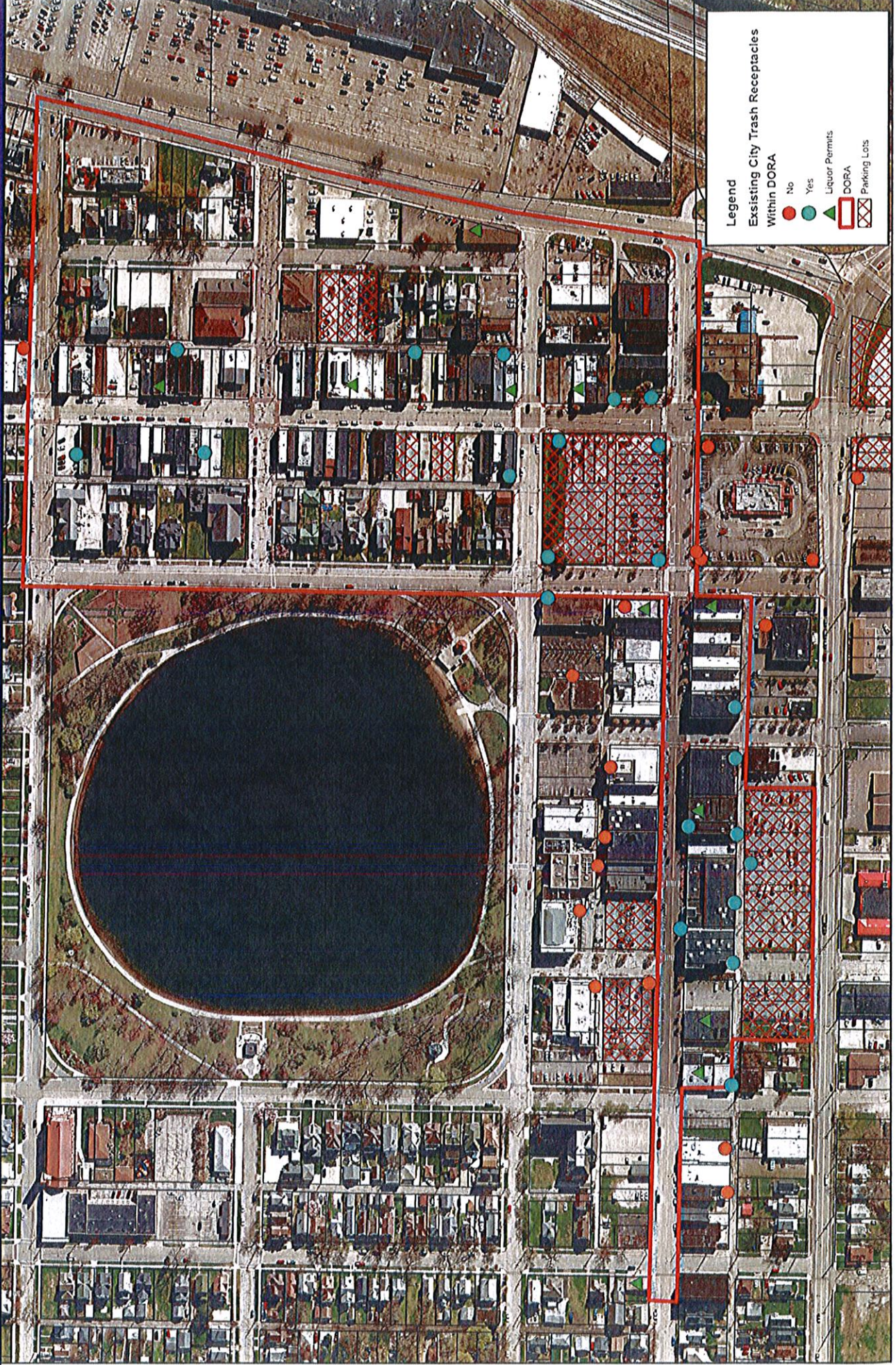

ORDINANCE NO. 98-2022

TITLE: DESIGNATED OUTDOOR REFRESHMENT AREA

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A DESIGNATED OUTDOOR REFRESHMENT AREA (DORA) PER ORC 4301.82, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this will be for the downtown area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Council hereby establishes a Designated Outdoor Refreshment Area (DORA) per ORC 4301.82.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is necessary to move forward with the State of Ohio, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
