ORDINANCE NO. 21-2025

TITLE: ENTER INTO CONTRACT T&M ASSOCIATES

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BARBERTON TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH T&M ASSOCIATES TO CARRY OUT THE RECENTLY AWARDED \$500,000 U.S. EPA ASSESSMENT BROWNFIELD GRANT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The City sent out for Requests for Qualifications (RFQ's) and the City received bids from three consulting firms; and

WHEREAS, The USEPA Grants Committee, including Denny Weaver, Todd Shreve, Fulton Benya, Kyle Breiding, and Stacy Carr reviewed all three firms and came to an unanimous decision that T&M Associates was the most qualified to carry out the grant from the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Council hereby authorized the City of Barberton to enter into contract with T&M Associates to carry out the recently awarded \$500,000.00 U.S. EPA Assessment Brownfield Grant.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order to facilitate timeliness, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
