## **ORDINANCE NO. 39-2025**

## TITLE: AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 98-2022 "DESIGNATED OUTDOOR REFRESHMENT AREA"

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 98-2022, BY AMENDING SECTION 6 "DESIGNATED HOURS OF OPERATION" FROM THURSDAY THROUGH SATURDAY TO MONDAY THROUGH SUNDAY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS**, this request comes with the approval of Mayor William B. Judge, Chief of Police Vince Morber, and the Director of Public Safety Jaime Iceman; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio, that:

**SECTION 1.** Council hereby amends Ordinance No. 98-2022, "Designated Hours of Operation" by amending Section 6 titled "Designated Hours of Operation" from Thursday through Saturday to Monday through Sunday by showing said amendments with a strikethrough for any deletions and **bold** for any additions.

**SECTION 2.** The Designated Outdoor Refreshment Area will be in operation on **Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday,** Thursday, Friday, and Saturday and Sunday from noon till 10pm. Additional days and extended times for special events may be established by the Mayor, Chief of Police and the Director of Public Safety with the concurrence by a vote of City Council. Request for extended times for special events must be proposed at-least ninety (90) days prior to the event to ensure proper approval and planning.

**SECTION 3.** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is necessary to facilitate a timely implementation of this change, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
