ORDINANCE NO. 55-2025

**TITLE: ENTER INTO CONTRACT
NFP CORPORATION SERVICES (OH) INC., (NFP)**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH NFP CORPORATION SERVICES (OH) INC. (NFP), FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSULTING AND BROKERAGE SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF BARBERTON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Effective September 1, 2025 NFP Corporate Services will hold the current consulting fee for 2025 with a 0% increase for the period of September 1, 2025 through August 31, 2028 outline as follows; and

WHEREAS, September 1, 2025 through August 31, 2026 cost will not exceed \$36,000; and

WHEREAS, September 1, 2026 through August 31, 2027 cost will not exceed \$36,000; and

WHEREAS, September 1, 2027 through August 31, 2028 cost will not exceed \$36,000; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio

SECTION 1. SECTION 1. That Council hereby authorized the Mayor, or his designee, to enter into contract with NFP Corporation Services (OH) Inc. (NFP) for the purpose of consulting and brokerage services for the City of Barberton.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order to expedite the contract due to the expiration of the current contract, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
