ORDINANCE NO. 62-2025

**TITLE: AUTHORIZE PAYMENT
OHIO EDISON**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO AUTHORIZE PAYMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$14,898.59 TO OHIO EDISON FOR THE REMOVAL OF LIGHT POLES ON 2ND STREET NORTHWEST, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council approval through an ordinance is required for additional authorization of purchase orders dated after the obligation date when the amount exceeds Three Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$3,000.00).

WHEREAS, the original Purchase Order and Board of Control was approved in November of 2024 for First Energy. However, the payment needs to be issued to Ohio Edison; and

WHEREAS, due to the Purchase Order being dated for 2024, amending the current Purchase Order to reflect the correct vendor is not able to be done.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to pay Fourteen Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-Eight Dollars and Fifty-Nine Cents (\$14,898.59) to Ohio Edison for the removal of light poles on 2nd Street Northwest.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason to allow this project to begin quickly, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
