RESOLUTION NO. 68-2025

**TITLE: ADJUSTED FINAL RESOLUTION
ODOT – PID 122321 – N VAN BUREN**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BARBERTON
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO REVISE THE CONTRACT WITH THE OHIO
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF N
VAN BUREN (PID 122321) AND NEARBY AREA TO INSTALL AND REBUILD
SIDEWALK, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 3-2025 was passed agreeing to participate, and Resolution No. 41-2025 was passed for Final Legislation contracting with the State of Ohio for the project committing our share (\$159,940.00); and

WHEREAS, This legislation revises the previous legislation based on actual bids that ODOT received higher than the estimated cost; and

WHEREAS, ODOT revised the total cost of our share to \$165,118.00. The additional amount of \$5,178.00 is required by the State of Ohio for all such work, which shall be held in an escrow account to pay our share of the project cost for the duration of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City of Barberton, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. That Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to revise the contract with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) for the improvement of N Van Buren (PID 122321) and nearby area to install and rebuild sidewalk

SECTION 2. That is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order to have a certified copy of the legislation returned to ODOT in a timely manner, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
