ORDINANCE NO. 101-2025

**TITLE: APPROPRIATION
POLICE DEPARTMENT**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$10,000.00 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE GENERAL FUND TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT’S OPERATING AND MAINTENANCE BUDGET OF THE GENERAL FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Police Department applied for and received a MDT/Keyboard grant from the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services (#IA-0000001033); and

WHEREAS, the grant needs to be utilized by the end of the year; and

WHEREAS, the grant is a reimbursement; and

WHEREAS, this appropriation will put the money in the Police budget for the department to spend, send in for reimbursement, and then Finance Director Flaker will put the money back into the General Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$10,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Item of the General Fund to the Police Department’s Operating and Maintenance Budget of the General Fund.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of it’s committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order to facilitate timely and continued implementation, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after it’s passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
