ORDINANCE NO. 124-2025

**TITLE: ENTER INTO CONTRACT
KENMORE CONSTRUCTION (KENMORE)
STRATFORD RD WATER MAIN**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH KENMORE CONSTRUCTION (KENMORE) TO REPLACE THE WATER MAIN ON STRATFORD ROAD, FOR A TOTAL BID COST OF \$916,350.00, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, 49.1%, approximately \$450,000.00, was awarded from the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC); and

WHEREAS, this project will be replacing a 6” water main on Stratford with an 8” water main that provides water service and fire protection to the residents; and

WHEREAS, Kenmore Construction Company was selected through a sealed bid process, was recommended by B&N, and was determined to be the lowest and best bid received.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Council hereby authorized the Mayor, or his designee, to enter into contract with Kenmore Construction, in the amount of Nine Hundred Sixteen Thousand Three Hundred Fifty Dollars and No Cents (\$916,350.00) to replace the water main on Stratford Road.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order to commence with contract execution and pre-construction coordination, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
